

- **US Highway 101 closure - Thursday, November 6**

US Highway 101 has been closed from the WA Highway 112 junction west of Port Angeles, to the WA Highway 113 junction at Sappho, due to wind-related hazards. Current information from WA Department of Transportation suggests the road will reopen tomorrow.

- **Safety Advisory: Mountain Goats**

NPS has received reports of aggressive mountain goats near trails at Hurricane Ridge, Royal Basin, Seven Lakes Basin, Lake of the Angeles, & Grand Pass. Visitors are required to maintain a distance of at least 50 yards from all wildlife.
