Navy Cherry Point Range Complex Training

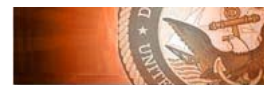
The Navy Cherry Point Range Complex represents an essential combination of sea and air space that provides realistic training areas for Navy personnel.
